Stops in all five boroughs will consist of deliveries to homeless shelters and actively looking for the homeless on the streets, in the subways, under bridges, in bus terminals and the parks in order to provide clothing and necessities.

Foundation has expanded its vision to not only educate through its **Educational Literacy Organization**, but to also feed and clothe the homeless citizens in America.

**The Book Bank Foundation** currently travels between New York City & Atlanta, GA to which both cities **Glenn Toby** resides, distributing items to the homeless. Each individual contacted is personally given new items of clothing and other necessities to assist him or her during the winter months. The overall goal of this initiative continues to positively impact the quality of life for the homeless population.
